HEROIN

CARFENTANIL

tranquilizer used for elephants or tigers

100x more potent than heroin

10,000x more potent than morphine

FENTANYL

50x more potent than heroin

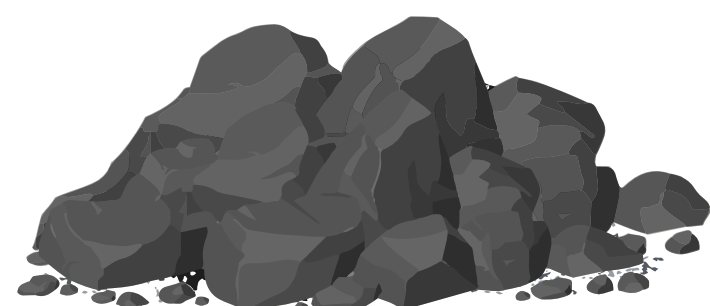

synthetic opioid known as "Pink"

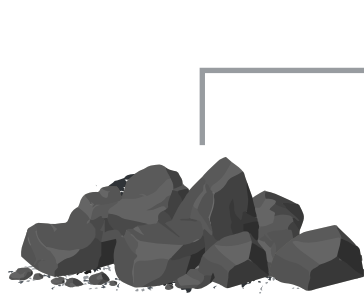
7-8x more potent than morphine

COMMON SIDE EFFECTS

Pale face that feels cold/clammy

Body that goes limp

Fingernails are blue or purple in color

Vomiting

Making gurgling noises (due to blocked airway)

Not able to rouse/wake the person

Breathing or heart beat slows or stops
